STUDYING THE PSALMS

PSALM 23

SHEPHERD

David explains that God shepherds by 1) leading besides still waters 2) restoring the soul 3) leading to paths of righteousness for his glory. Where else do you see this character of God mentioned in scripture? *John 10:11-18*. What other scriptures can you think of? Why do you assume God being a shepherd makes David not want or feel he's lacking in anything? How do you see God being a shepherd in your life

LEADER

Twice, David mentions this characteristic of God in the text. Where has God led you in life? How has God led you in life?

PRESENT

Even though the circumstances looked dire (walking through the valley of the shadow of death), David wholeheartedly knew God was still with him. Do you feel that God is with you?

The text implies that God's heart is to bring us good. To restore someone's soul would mean that it was lost or needed to be brought or put back. God sees that and brings it back to life.

What do you think restoring a soul means? How does this make you feel?

Are there parts of your soul you feel need to be restored or renewed?

RIGHTEOUS

God leads with purpose. According to the text, it's for his righteousness and glory. How does the bible define righteousness and its paths? Where have you seen it mentioned in scripture? What do you find when you look it up?

COMFORTER

David was comforted by the tools, protection, and guidance God uses to lead us.

6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

PROVIDER PLANNER

What is God doing when we walk with him? David says that he's preparing a table for us. Even when it looks like defeat, God triumphs over it. Where else in scripture have you seen this side of God's character? Romans 8:26; Exodus 15, Exodus 17. Why should you feel confident that God is doing the same with you?

REDEEMER

The text implies that God brought David purpose and a sense of belonging. In I Samuel, God anointed David as the next king of Israel. In this text, David isn't king yet but he remembers the purpose God gave him instead of focusing on the dark times he's facing.

- What season of life is David in, circumstance? Does it relate to the one you're in? What are some tips you can take from this psalm and apply to your season?

Despite death looking near to David, he feared no evil because he knew that God was his shepherd and if God was leading him besides still waters and had anointed him in the past, this couldn't be the end. David knew that even in this, God was still working on his behalf. He found comfort in knowing that God hadn't abandoned him.

David knows 'I shall not want' because God is leading him and God has told us in his word that he knows what we need before a word is even on our lips (Psalm 139:4).

God is not in a hurry with me. He wants me not to run but to walk next to him, the everlasting well that never runs dry (John 4). A well that can't be shaken or moved because God doesn't change or alter himself.

If I ever doubt why I should follow God and walk with him, David tells me it's because God won't lead me astray. The path of still waters leads me to a purpose, a plan, and a future.





FINAL STUDY NOTES

MAIN POINTS OF THE PSALM

- God is my shepherd
- God will help and restore me
- God has a purpose and plan for my life
- God is leading regardless of how things may look

WHAT RESONATED IN THE PSALM

David knew that God wasn't leading him aimlessly. In his hardship, David was still anointed. He looked towards the hope of becoming King that God gave him in previous seasons when he wasn't going through dark times. Because God was with him, David knew that God's blessings and attributes also followed him including God's goodness and mercy.
