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## Study Notes

Read through Genesis 1:1-31.

What are the seven days of creation? Can you list what God created on each day?

What are five qualities or characteristics you notice about God?

How do the three members of the Godhead (Father, Son, and Spirit) identify themselves?

What is something God describes that is different from how the world describes it?

for example, how does a day start and end?

What are common beliefs that this chapter invalidates?

Who or what was created in God's image?

What commands did God give to his creations?

for example, what did he say to the moon? the land? birds? mankind?

What do we notice about the world and its partnership with all aspects of creation?

How do you think God wants us to perceive goodness?

How does God's definition of good differ from the world's?
