Study Notes

Read through Genesis 3:1-24.

- Did the man and the woman lack anything prior to this chapter? In your own words, what are some issues that arise during the conversation in Genesis 3:1-5?
- How was the woman tempted to sin as opposed to the man?
 - Why do you think the woman was tempted before the man?
- When you read Genesis 3:7, what do you think their eyes were opened to?
 - How did eating the forbidden fruit disobey God's command in Genesis 2:16-17?
- What do you notice about God's character in Genesis 3:8-9?
 - Why do you think God called the man first even though both the man and the woman had eaten the forbidden fruit?
 - Identify two or three emotions Adam felt after eating the forbidden fruit.
- How did God curse the man as opposed to the woman as opposed to the serpent?
 - How do you think the sin of Adam and Eve affected the earth since they were given dominion over it in Genesis 2?

Study Notes

- The serpent told Eve that eating the forbidden fruit would make her more like God.
 - Read Genesis 3:22, can what the serpent said in Genesis 3:4-5 be considered true? How was it also deceitful?
 - Read Matthew 4:1–11, how is the serpent's interaction with Eve similar to Jesus being tempted in the wilderness?
- What are some ways you've been tempted to disobey God today? How does this relate to Adam and Eve's experience in the garden?
- How did Adam justify sinning in Genesis 3:12? How did Eve justify sinning in Genesis 3:13?
 - What does this tell you about sin?
- In what ways can sin affect an individual's relationship with God? What scripture supports this?
 - In what ways can sin affect a community's relationship with God?
 - How can sin affect an individual's relationship with others?
- In your own words, how would you describe God's righteous anger? When was this displayed? What was it a result of?
