## Study Notes

#### Read through Genesis 4.

- What is a parallel you notice regarding Abel's work, King David's (1 Samuel 16), and The Messiah's (John 10)?
- How was Abel after God's heart?
- Why did God hold Abel's offering to a higher regard than his brother, Cain?
- How does God describe sin in verse 7? How does this description parallel with the enemy's scheme in 1 Peter 5:8?
- How would you describe Cain's calling? How did sin affect this calling?
  - How did sin affect Cain?
  - How did Cain's sin affect Abel?
  - How might our sins affect ourselves and others?
- What emotions overtook Cain and what did they lead him to do against Abel?
  - What does this tell us about the nature of sin?
  - What does this tell us about the end result of sin?
- How would you describe God's character in this text?
  - How did God confront Cain's sin?
  - How is this similar to Genesis 3:8-11?

#### Study Notes

- Read Hebrews 11:3-5, why was Abel's offering acceptable as opposed to Cain's?
  - Was Cain justified in being angry at God?
  - Did Cain repent for taking his brother's life?
  - What was God's punishment to Cain?
  - What acts of mercy did God show Cain?
    - Why did God mark Cain?
- What act of redemption did God show Eve?
  - How did God bring hope to a hopeless situation?
- How was sin reflected in the life of Cain's descendant, Lamech?
  - How does Lamech's action in verse 19 oppose God's command in Genesis 2:24?
  - What else does this tell us about sin?
- What do you think it means that 'Cain went away from the presence of The Lord'?
  - How might our actions and sin keep us from the presence of The Lord?
    - How might this affect our loved ones, families, and/or generations to come?
