## Study Notes

- According to Genesis 11:10-32, which bloodline of the sons of Noah is Abram a descendent of?
- Reflect on Genesis 12:
  - Why did God choose Abram and how does this reflect and connect with God's word regarding the prophecies on Noah's family (Genesis 9:18–29)?
- God called Abram to a land Abram did not yet know:
  - What does this tell you about God's ways in guiding his children?
    - How does this passage align with Psalm 23?
  - What were the promises made by God to Abram?
  - How did Abram walk out his faith?
- What led Abram to lie to the Egyptians?
  - How does this connect to God's word in Proverbs 29:25?
- How did God display his mercy to Abram in Egypt?
  - How did God honor the word he gave to Abram in Genesis 12:3?
  - Abram gave his wife to Pharaoh, how did God restore Abram and Sarai's marriage? How did he honor the word he gave to Abram in Genesis 12:7?
- God called Abram to a land that was in the midst of a famine:
  - What does this tell us about how circumstances might look in the midst of God's calling?
- How was Abram's faith tested?
  - How might our faith be tested in seasons of uncertainty?
- How might fear hinder our ability to hear God, honor God, and walk out our faith?
- God made promises to Abram without condition:
  - Did Abram's behavior in Egypt stop God from fulfilling his promises?
    - what does this show us about God's character?
  - Why is this comforting? How does this reflect Joshua 21:45?
  - What does this tell us about God's plan for his children?
    - How does this reflect Romans 8:28?
- Why is it important to know that God's promises don't come with conditions?
