## Study Notes

- What promise does God make to Abram in Genesis 15:1?
  - How does Abram respond to this promise? How does he express it to God?
- What promise does God make to Abram in Genesis 15:4-5?
- Genesis 15:6 is a popularly quoted verse in the New Testament, why is this verse important in understanding faith and what it means to be a Christian?
- What was the purpose of the gathering of animals in Genesis 15:9?
  - What was God establishing with Abram?
- How is God's sovereignty and grace and deity highlighted in Genesis 15:12 and in Genesis 15:17?
- What promises does God make in the covenant he establishes with Abram?
- Would God's covenant with Abram be considered physical or spiritual?
- Read Luke 1 and compare it to Genesis 15.
  - In Luke 1, God causes Zechariah to go silent when he doubts God's promise that his wife, Elizabeth, will bear a son. While Mary isn't rebuked for similar concerns she has towards bearing a son, The Messiah.
    - Zechariah expresses doubt in his response to God's promise, why was he held to a higher standard of faith than Abram? What was different between the time Zechariah doubted God's words to the time Abram received his promise from God?
    - Mary reveals faith in her response to God's promise despite her uncertainties, how is her response similar to that of Abram's in Genesis 15?
